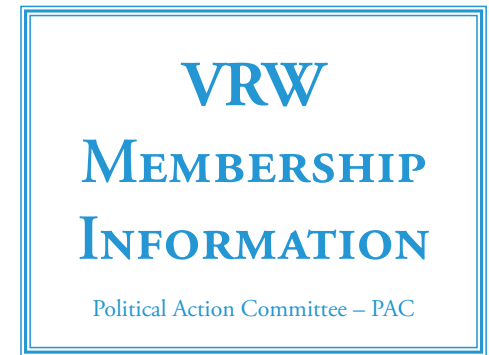


THE REPUBLICAN PHILOSOPHY

WE BELIEVE...

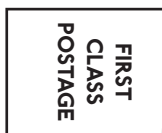
- ★ That the right of the individual to achieve the best that is within him, as long as he respects the rights of others, is the source of our Nation's strength.

HISTORY OF OUR ORGANIZATION

Village Republican Women (VRW) got its start in the early 1960s as the Precinct 273 Republican Women's Club. Fourteen women from the Memorial Villages formed the original group whose aim was to assist precinct chairs with voter registration, identify Republican voters and fund-raise on behalf of the GOP.

While our role has stayed the same in some areas, it has greatly changed in others. Much of our focus remains on voter registration and Get Out The Vote (GOTV) efforts, but educating voters, advocating on the issues of our day and volunteering with Republican campaigns have become increasingly important to our mission.

Meaningful community involvement is also vital to our Club and literacy has long been a focus of VRW. We continue that effort today, primarily with Piney Point Elementary School in HISD.
